The Organ Committee are glad to be able to inform the Subscribers to the Fund and the Members of the Congregation generally, that they have felt themselves justified in ordering the first portion of the New Organ according to the Specification annexed to their Report of the 7th March last, and they hope that nothing will prevent the new Organ being erected during the ensuing Summer.

The Cost thus to be incurred including the preparations in the Church will, as mentioned in the former report, amount to £350.

In publishing the first List of Subscribers to the Fund, the Committee wish to explain that it has been found impossible to make a personal canvass of the whole Congregation. Believing that many persons whose names do not as yet appear in the List are willing to contribute towards the cost of the new Instrument, the Committee earnestly request all intending Subscribers to communicate with some Member of the Committee, or to pay their Subscriptions into the Organ Fund Account at the NATIONAL PROVINCIAL BANK, without waiting for a personal application.

In addition to the sums appearing in the annexed List, a munificent Contribution of £120 was offered anonymously through the Rev. THOMAS IZOD, the only stipulations being that the gift should be allowed to remain anonymous, and that the new Instrument should be thoroughly efficient and as complete as possible.

The Committee gladly accepted the very valuable assistance thus offered, and only regret that they are unable to express their gratitude to the generous Donor in a more direct manner.

The £120 has been paid into the Organ Fund Account at the Bank, and in order to give effect as nearly as possible to the intentions of the Donor, the Committee have determined to apply one moiety of this sum towards the present expenditure, and to reserve the remaining £60 in aid of the costs of completing the Instrument.

It will be observed however, that a further sum must still be provided, to enable the Committee to pay for the portion of the Instrument already ordered, and a still larger sum to complete the whole design, and the Committee appeal to the Congregation generally for further support and assistance.

Any Member of the Committee will be happy to give information and receive Subscriptions, which can also be paid to the Organ Fund Account at the National Provincial Bank.
