

# ST. PAUL'S CHURCH, HONITON.

The first portion of the Organ having been completed and placed in the Church the Committee think it right to present a further report to the Subscribers to the fund, and to bring the matter again under the notice of the Congregation generally.

In the former reports the estimated Cost of the portion of the Instrument already erected, including the expense of preparing the site, was stated to be £350. The total expense attending the preparation of the site has not yet been ascertained, but the Committee believe that the liabilities already incurred will not exceed the estimate.

Feeling the desirability of completing the Instrument as soon as possible, the Committee immediately after the existing portion was erected, requested the Builders to furnish a Specification of the additions which they considered necessary.

This Specification has now been received, together with an estimate of the expense, and the Committee find that owing to the large advance which has taken place since the first contract was entered into both in the price of material and in the cost of labour, the addition of the least expensive Swell which will be sufficient for the requirements of the Church, and the addition to the Pedal Organ of one of the Stops already provided for, will cost £335.

Mr. BISHOP however strongly recommends that three Stops besides those mentioned in his Specification should be placed in the proposed Swell, the additional cost of which will be £100.

A List of Subscribers to this time is enclosed, from which it will be seen that £469 19s. 8d. has been already subscribed, and that £315 remains to be raised to enable the Committee to complete the Instrument in a manner worthy of the object which the Congregation had in view in setting the movement on foot.

The expenditure of this further sum will without doubt put the Congregation in possession of an Instrument second to none in any Parish Church in the Diocese.

The Builders have offered to complete the new work by the end of April next, provided the order is given at once.

The Committee do not however feel justified in giving the order until they have received such assurances of support as will satisfy them that the funds necessary to pay for the work when completed will be forthcoming, but they have much pleasure in announcing that a Member of the Congregation has generously offered to provide such sum as may be necessary, not exceeding £100, to enable the three further Stops above mentioned to be added to the Swell Organ, on condition that the £215 necessary to complete the other portion of the Instrument be subscribed within such a time as will allow the Committee to embrace the offer of the builders to execute the further Contract by the end of April.

It will be seen therefore that **only £215** remain to be raised among the Congregation generally to complete the Instrument, and the Committee trust that they shall within a short time receive such assurances of support as will enable them to give the order for the work.
